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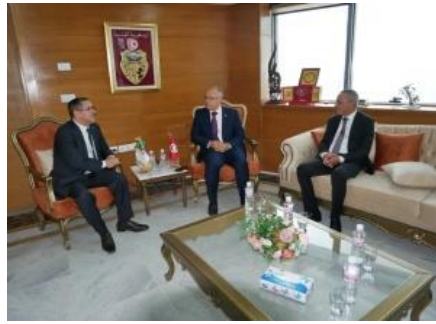
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The Algerian-German Economic Forum opens its proceedings in Berlin

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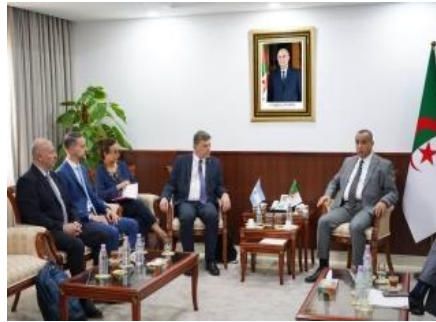
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Adjal receives a delegation from the Argentinian company "INVAP"
