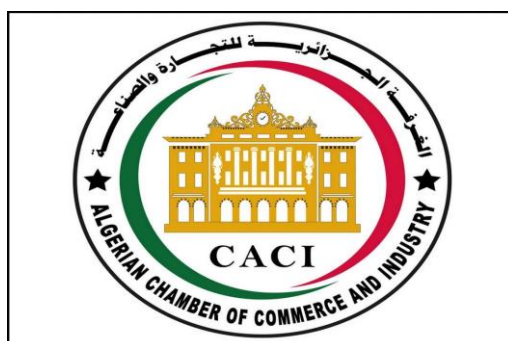


Algeria's arguments for producing 27 million tonnes/year of hydrogen by 2040 in the Arab world

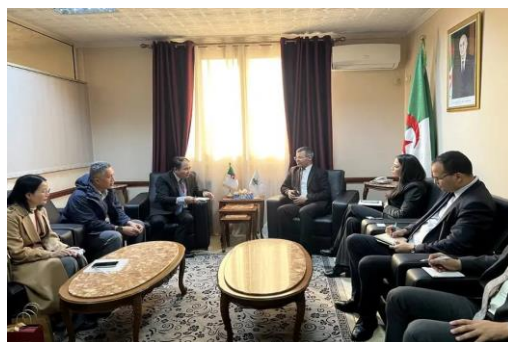
Signing of more than 50 cooperation and partnership agreements
