The International Monetary Fund (IMF) has estimated Algeria's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) for 2026, based on the "purchasing power parity" (PPP) criterion, at \$915 billion, with forecasts exceeding \$1 trillion by 2029, placing the country among the four largest economies in the Arab region and the African continent.
