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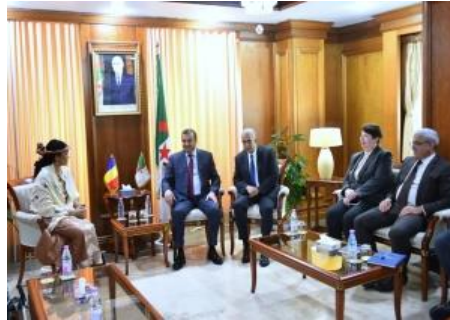
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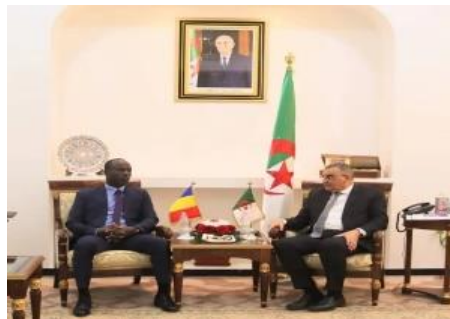
Algeria-Chad: Examination of ways to strengthen cooperation in the hydrocarbons and mining sectors

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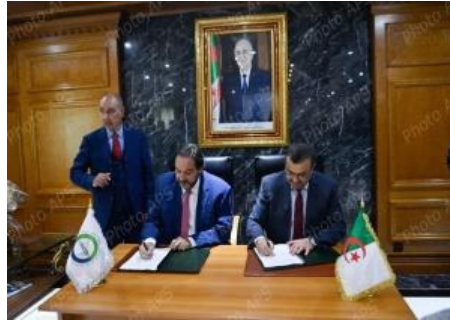
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Algeria signs a roadmap to strengthen cooperation with OLACDE
