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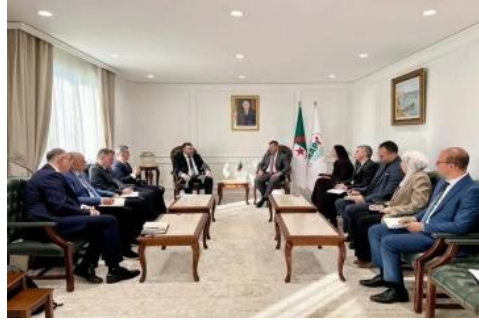
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AAPI is examining industrial and energy projects with a delegation from Bosnia and Herzegovina
